

# Product Safety Recall

## "JESSE" TIMBER BUNK BED

Sleep City stores have been selling the "Jesse" bunk bed product, as either a Single Bunk or Study Bunk with Desk ("Bunk Bed").

The Bunk Bed has been available for sale between June 2009 and December 2010.



**Defect:** Some Bunk Beds may not meet the mandatory Australian safety Standard for the design and construction of Bunk Beds. The defects are:

- the instructions do not require the mattress slats to be fixed to the mattress base during assembly and so they may move;
- some of the corner posts protrude; and
- some of the gaps between the rungs of the guardrail around the top Bunk may be too wide.

**Hazard:** This may present possible entrapment and strangulation hazards.

**What to do:** If you have purchased a Jesse Bunk Bed, you should immediately de-couple the Bunk Bed so that the top Bunk is on the floor. It is safe to use while on the floor. Sleep City will provide a replacement Bunk Bed to you at no cost. Replacement Bunk Beds will be available in approximately 8-10 weeks' time.
